SUMMER SCHOOL 2020

At summer school, children and adolescents can catch up on lessons to make up for learning deficits due to school closures. Participation is voluntary and free of charge.

What are the benefits?

- ▶ Overcoming difficulties at school and with language skills
- ▶ Developing subject-specific and social skills

How is the programme organised?

There will be an information or concluding meeting before and after the summer school involving the pupil, the teacher, the parents and the summer school teacher.

PRIMARY SCHOOL

- ▶ Grades 1 and 2
- ▶ Three weeks during the summer holidays, and also one week during the autumn holidays if requested
- ▶ Learning opportunities: maths, reading, writing, English for young learners

- ▶ Mon – Fri, 9am – 12 noon or 1pm – 4pm
- ▶ At your own school or one nearby
- ▶ Lessons in small groups
- ▶ Note of participation on the certificate as a special achievement

Who can use this programme?

Pupils of grades 1, 2 and 7, 8, 9 and Welcome Classes

- ▶ who were deprived of learning as a result of the Corona-related school closures or
- ▶ are exempt from co-payment for learning materials or
- ▶ are eligible under the Education and Participation Act or
- ▶ are new to Germany and need language support.

What are the requirements?

- ▶ Recommendation and support from the school
- ▶ Parental consent

SECONDARY SCHOOL

- ▶ Grades 7 to 9
- ▶ Two weeks during the summer or autumn holidays or both
- ▶ Learning opportunities: maths German, first foreign language
